

MSA has become aware of a labeling error involving Hi-Viz Models of V-Gard 500 Vented Protective Caps. Affected helmets were shipped from November 8, 2011 through April 26, 2012 and include the following part numbers:

Part Number	Color and Suspension Type
10034026	Hi-Viz Orange with Fas-Trac® suspension
10034035	Hi-Viz Orange with 6 point suspension
10074819	Hi-Viz Yellow/Green with Fas-Trac® suspension
10074820	Hi-Viz Yellow/Green with 6 point suspension

The label affixed to the inside surface of these helmets incorrectly indicates that the helmet is an ANSI Z89.1 Class E helmet. This designation indicates the helmet provides electrical protection. The label should indicate that the helmet is an ANSI Z89.1 Class C helmet, thus indicating that it is conductive and does <u>not</u> provide electrical protection.

Do not use these helmets for electrical protection. Since the V-Gard 500 Helmet is a vented design, it will not provide electrical protection.





Please inspect the label on the above helmets in your possession. If any indicate "Class E", please contact MSA Customer Service at 1-866-672-0005 to obtain the appropriate quantity of replacement labels. Upon receiving the labels (indicating "Class C"), please affix the replacement label over the existing incorrect label.
